Res. No. 201-32-33. By Alderman Messner.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Sheboygan:

THAT WHEREAS, the City of Sheboygan has for a number of years made large deposits of earth and other miscellaneous material on the shore of Lake Michigan immediately north of the Coast Guard Station, and from thence in an irregular line to the North Pier, and

THAT WHEREAS, the placing of such deposits and the alteration of the shore line occasioned thereby appears to be a violation of the River and Harbor Act Approved by Congress on March 3, 1899, and

THAT WHEREAS, a continuance of such conduct on the part of the City of Sheboygan may subject it to penalties therefor provided,

THAT THE CITY ATTORNEY BE AND HE IS BY THE ADOPTION OF THIS REPORT, authorized and directed forthwith to prepare a suitable petition to the Secretary of War to formally extend permission to the City of Sheboygan to continue the work now being carried on, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Engineer in collaboration with the Board of Public Works and the Superintendent of Parks be and they are hereby authorized and directed to immediately prepare or procure a suitable map or other illustrative document showing the proposed extent of the alterations to the shore line intended by the City of Sheboygan, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a duly certified copy of this resolution be, after passage, forwarded to the Chief of Engineers of the War Department, Major H. M. Trippe, District Engineer, and Representative M. K. Reilly of this Congressional District.
